*There are two types of cases: **A NON-FOOD CASE** = 100 Disposable plates, 100 Napkins, 10 Trash Bags (55 gal), 1 Bottles of Shampoo, 3 Sticks of Men's Deodorant, 1 Can of Athlete's Foot Spray, 1 Container of Foot Powder, 10 Rolls of Toilet, 10 Toothbrushes, 3 Tubes of Toothpaste, 1 Gallon Fabuloso (All-purpose cleaner), 1 Gallon Bleach, 75 Disposable Forks, 25 Disposable Spoons, 100 Disposable Cups. **A FOOD CASE** = 1 liter Vegetable/ Olive Oil, 1 lb. Pinto Beans, 1 lb. Sugar, 1 lb Rice, 10 Cans Tuna, 2 jars Peanut Butter, 2 jars Jelly, 2 jars Mayonnaise, 1 boxes of Graham crackers, 2 boxes of granola bars, 24 juice boxes or cans.

- We promise to collect and donate ___ cases of supplies to Project Mexico & St. Innocent Orthodox Orphanage during the 2019 Great Lenten period.
- We commit to "Pray and Pack" so as we prepare the cases of food we will pray for the children and families who are suffering.
