

## **The Demetrios K. Pantazis Memorial Academic Scholarship Award**

Demetrios K. Pantazis was known for always helping others and devoted his entire life to making others' dreams come true. During his youth, he spent his days working and his evenings going to night school. Although, he wanted to go to a University, it was not financially feasible at the time. With this Scholarship, the Pantazis family hopes to honor his memory by giving a student the ability to fulfill their dream of going to college.

The Demetrios K. Pantazis Scholarship Award is awarded to a student who demonstrates compassion and commitment to humanitarian causes in their local community and beyond. Students in the Greek Orthodox Community, who have community-based humanitarian experiences and have a desire to help ease the suffering of people who are less fortunate, are eligible.

The primary criterion for the award is a Student's volunteer experience.

### **Eligibility**

- Must be currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior student.
- Must be involved in at least 2 Greek Orthodox Youth Groups.
- Funds must be used towards a College/University or Vocational School.

1. Write a 500-word essay revealing how these funds will help in your personal quest for higher learning. Please cite personal experiences that illustrate examples of humanitarian or philanthropic efforts in social settings for community service. Include ideologies or people who have influenced your decision to pursue education and vocational aspirations.
2. Please include a list of at least 3 volunteer/humanitarian experiences that have allowed you to help others and the impact it had on the individual and on yourself.
3. Please include 2 reasons why these funds will assist you in furthering your Education.
4. Three letters of recommendation: One from your parish priest, second from a teacher or school official, and third from a person that can validate your desire to serve.
5. In 500 words or less describe your involvement and participation within the Youth Ministry programs of our Orthodox Church and their affect on your life.
